

Downspout Extensions

Control rainwater drainage to save your flowers, plants and house foundation

Exit from underground, extended downspouts

- Install elbow to end of drain pipe
- Punch holes in bottom of elbow
- Install gravel at bottom of elbow for proper drainage and reduce potential for clogging
- Cap top of elbow with exit grate

Advantages:

- Holes allow water to drain from standpipe (elbow) to eliminate standing water
- Gravel prevents clogging of holes and allows for better drainage
- Installation of elbow at end reduces/eliminates chances of a collapsed exit point

If not properly controlled, drainage from your gutter runoff can cause costly damage to your home's landscape, basement and foundation. Grading the landscape is not enough to protect the foundation of your home.

Every downspout should have a downspout extension installed to direct the runoff a safe distance from your home.
